

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Tabling Proposed Ordinance, "Defining the Powers, Duties,
and Authority of the Office of Independent Counsel")

LEGIS. ORDER 212-89

1 WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 02-89, "Defining the Powers, Duties, and
2 Authority of the Office of Independent Counsel" was
3 vetoed by the Chairman of the Nation and failed an
4 override attempt by the Legislature; and

5 WHEREAS, an amended ordinance titled, "Defining the Powers,
6 Duties, and Authority of the Office of Independent
7 Counsel," which addressed the veto concerns of the
8 Chairman of the Nation, was proposed for Council
9 reconsideration; and

10 WHEREAS, this amended ordinance was not reviewed by any of the
11 newly appointed Legislative Committees; and

12 WHEREAS, a committee review by the Judiciary Committee was
13 requested before formal action by this Council is taken.

14 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
15 Council that the amended ordinance titled, "Defining
16 the Powers, Duties, and Authority of the Office of
17 Independent Counsel" is hereby tabled and referred to
18 the Legislative Judiciary Committee for review and
19 recommendation.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Judiciary Committee return their
21 recommendations concerning this topic to the next
22 session of the Legislative Council.


23 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
24 Council on the 9th. day of June, 1989 at a meeting at which a
25 quorum was present with a vote of 1,352.0 for; 289.0 against;
26 83.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in
27 the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution
28 of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham
29 Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy
30 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
31 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
32 Stat. 984).
