2 Council Meeting on June 16, 1989; and


3 WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Order No. 212-89, the Council

11 Office of Independent Counsel.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative

23 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
24 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
25 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
26 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
27 984).
