LEGIS. ORDER NO. 226-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council met to begin  
2 their July 1989 General Session; and

3 WHEREAS, the running agenda established for the week of July 10-  
4 14, 1989 was reviewed; and

5 WHEREAS, an opportunity was provided to include items for Council  
6 consideration not listed on the running agenda; and

- 20 i. Selection of Tribal-State Compact Negotiating Committee


21 WHEREAS, a recommendation was made not to address those proposed

25 running agenda for the week.


26 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham

57.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in  
the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution  
of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham  
Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy  
Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,  
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).
