

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Gu Achi District - Management and Operation of Quijotoa Store)

RES. NO. 230-89

1 WHEREAS, Gu Achi District Council met on July 3, 1989 to discuss  
2 the project of how to manage and operate the Quijotoa  
3 Trading Post; and

4 WHEREAS, the Parson Family who now has the lease on the said  
5 Trading Post have decided to pull out of the lease for  
6 personal reasons; and

7 WHEREAS, the District Council has decided to use the \$100,000.00  
8 that the Tribe has allocated to the District for  
9 Economic Development, and also the interest that has  
10 accrued from the said monies; and

11 WHEREAS, a budget has been developed to purchase merchandise  
12 goods, provide for salaries of employees, and to buy out  
13 the lease owner.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
15 Council that the Gu Achi District is hereby authorized  
16 to use its appropriated Economic Development Funds, with  
17 a current balance of \$111,140.00 to fund the proposed  
18 buy out of the Quijotoa Trading Post, and to provide  
19 operational funding as stated in the outlined budget.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Store Manager and others as  
21 designated by the District Council will have the  
22 authority to sign checks on the Trading Post Account  
23 which shall be established for the benefit of the  
24 operation of the Quijotoa Trading Post.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
26 Council reviewed the proposed Economic Development  
27 project and does hereby approve the Gu Achi District's  
28 Management and Operation of the Quijotoa Store budget in  
29 the amount of \$111,140.00.

30 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
31 on the 10th day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum  
32 was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not  
voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
