- WHEREAS, the Parson Family who now has the lease on the said

 Trading Post have decided to pull out of the lease for

 personal reasons; and
- WHEREAS, the District Council has decided to use the \$100,000.00

 that the Tribe has allocated to the District for
 Economic Development, and also the interest that has
 accrued from the said monies; and
- WHEREAS, a budget has been developed to purchase merchandise goods, provide for salaries of employees, and to buy out the lease owner.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative

 Council that the Gu Achi District is hereby authorized

 to use its appropriated Economic Development Funds, with
 a current balance of \$111,140.00 to fund the proposed
 buy out of the Quijotoa Trading Post, and to provide
 operational funding as stated in the outlined budget.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Store Manager and others as designated by the District Council will have the authority to sign checks on the Trading Post Account which shall be establieshed for the benefit of the operation of the Quijotoa Trading Post.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
 Council reviewed the proposed Economic Development
 project and does hereby approve the Gu Achi District's
 Management and Operation of the Quijotoa Store budget in
 the amount of \$111,140.00.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th. day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
