5 the following line items:


6 Utilities	271.00

13 carry them over the drought period.

15 Legislative Council does hereby grant these funds.

17 on the 11th. day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
18 was present with a vote of 1,198.5 for; 290.0 against; 235.5
19 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
20 Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of
21 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
22 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
23 Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
24 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
