

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Accept Recommendations of the Judiciary Committee on the
Proposed Ordinance regarding the Independent Counsel)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 237-89

1 WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee of the Legislature, pursuant to
2 Legislative Order No. 212-89, was charged with reviewing
3 and providing recommendations on the proposed ordinance
4 regarding the Independent Counsel; and

5 WHEREAS, on July 12, 1989, the Judiciary Committee did present
6 their written recommendations on the proposed ordinance,
7 "Defining the Powers, Duties and Authority of the Office
8 of Independent Counsel;" and

9 WHEREAS, the Judiciary Committee did not present a draft
10 ordinance for Council consideration; and

11 WHEREAS, a proposition was made to have the Domestic Affairs
12 Committee redraft the proposed ordinance in order to
13 incorporate the Judiciary Committee's recommendations.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
15 Council it hereby accepts the recommendations of the
16 Judiciary Committee concerning the proposed ordinance on
17 the Independent Counsel.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Domestic Affairs Committee is
19 hereby delegated the responsibility of incorporating the
20 recommendations of the Judiciary Committee into the
21 proposed ordinance.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Domestic Affairs Committee return
23 the redrafted ordinance at the next session of the
24 Council.

25 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham
26 Council on the 12th. day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a
27 quorum was present with a vote of 1,609.5 for; 114.5 against; -0-
28 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
29 Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of
30 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).
