LEGIS. ORDER NO. 239-89

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council's Rules and Procedures states in Section 1.E., PUBLIC HEARINGS:

- During the first General Session of the Legislature, the Legislature shall schedule and conduct public hearings to get input from the membership to set goals and objectives for the Tohono O'Odham Nation, and to report to the membership the status of the previous goals and objectives.
- The Legislative Committees may hold public hearings to obtain public input regarding their specific responsibilities and areas of jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee is recommending that five (5) public hearings be set up as follows:

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- 3. <u>San Simon</u> September 9, 1989
 Gu Vo District
 - Hickiwan District - Pisinemo District
- 4. Santa Rosa Boarding School September 24, 1989
 Sif Oidak District
 Gu Achi District
 Florence Village
- 5. Gila Bend October 14, 1989
 San Lucy District

WHEREAS, due to conflicts, the Legislative Council decided to amend the proposed date for the Santa Rosa Boarding School to September 16, 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby adopt the five (5) Public Hearings as recommended by the Rules Committee with the added amendment.
