LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL (Table FY'89 Tribal Housing Inventory)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 240-89 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs distributes HIP funds 1 based on Tribal Housing Inventories; and 2 WHEREAS, the Nation has conducted a reassessment of the housing 3 needs of the reservation to be included in a "Tribal 4 Plan for the use of HIP funds"; and 5 WHEREAS, the Legislative Housing Committee and the Tohono O'odham 6 Housing Authority did present this assessment to the 7 Council; and 8 WHEREAS, it was found that discrepancies existed within the 9 housing inventory assessment with the actual number of 10 housing in the various districts of the Nation. 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative 12 Council that action is hereby tabled on the Tohono 13 O'odham Housing Inventory to provide the districts with 14 discrepancies to contact the Tohono O'odham Housing 15 Authority to make corrections of the housing inventory 16 in their respective districts. 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this issue be returned to the Council 18 during the August General Session. 19 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham 20 Council on the <u>12th</u>. day of <u>July</u>, <u>1989</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; <u>-0-</u> against; <u>-0-</u> not voting; and <u>01</u> absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section <u>1 (a)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation 21 22 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant 23 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 24 984). 25 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 26 27 Manuel, Legislative Chairman ForEdward D. 28 29 ATTEST: 30 hon 31 Teresa M.
