

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Equal Employment Opportunity Commission - FY 90)

RES. NO. 248-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Tribal  
2 Employment Rights Office since 1978 and has successfully  
3 met the needs of the Tohono O'Odham people; and

4 WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'Odham Tribal Employment  
5 Rights Office has been supplemented by the Equal  
6 Employment Opportunity Commission; and

7 WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights  
8 Office is essential to eradicate employment  
9 discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the  
10 Tohono O'Odham Nation.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Council that  
12 it hereby approves the continued funding for the Tribal  
13 Employment Rights Office from the Equal Employment  
14 Opportunity Commission.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be  
16 October 01, 1989 through September 30, 1990.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
18 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
19 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are  
20 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,  
21 provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
22 funding or funding levels of the grant shall be  
23 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
25 on the 13th. day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum  
26 was present with a vote of 1,516.0 for; -0- against; 208.0 not  
27 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
28 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
29 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
30 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
31 Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
32 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
