

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(The Elderly Program Title VI Grant Budget)

RES. NO. 24-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a
2 program for the elderly members of the Nation; and

3 WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has
4 been possible in part by Article VI of the Older
5 American's Act of 1965 as amended; and

6 WHEREAS, the Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding by
7 submitting a proposal to the Office of Human Development
8 Services, Administration on Aging; and

9 WHEREAS, the Elderly proposal will benefit elder members of the
10 Tohono O'odham Nation by providing for their nutritional
11 and social support services.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
13 Council that it does hereby approve the proposal for
14 continued funding of the Elderly Program to provide
15 services to eligible members of the Tohono O'odham
16 Nation.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this Grant shall Commence
18 on April 01, 1989 and end on March 31, 1990.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
20 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
21 Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are
22 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this Grant,
23 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
24 funding or funding levels of this Grant shall be
25 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
27 that the indirect cost be waived for the Elderly Program
28 Title VI Grant.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
30 on the 26th day of January, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
31 was present with a vote of 1,392.0 for; -0- against; 248.0 not
32 voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursu-
ant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
