

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(United Way Funding FY '90)

RES. NO. 254-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Services under an
3 agreement with United Way of Tucson; and

4 WHEREAS, such services for the youth have been successful and
5 beneficial; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to enter into an
7 agreement for services during FY '90; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Youth Services/Juvenile Delinquency
9 Prevention has submitted a budget for review and
10 approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
12 Council that it does support and authorize the Tohono
13 O'Odham Nation to enter into an agreement with United
14 Way of Tucson for Juvenile Delinquency Prevention
15 Services.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
17 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
18 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
19 being conducted and no executed agreement has been
20 awarded by the United Way of Tucson Agency.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
22 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
23 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
24 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
25 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
26 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
27 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

28 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council
29 on the 14th day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
30 was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
31 voting; and 06 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
32 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
