

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham Skill Center FY '90)

RES. NO. 256-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
2 Tohono O'Odham Skill Center Program under a three (3)
3 year grant with the U.S. Department of Education, Office
4 of Vocational and Adult Education; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is desirous to
6 continue to provide Vocational and Education Training
7 Program to Native Americans; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Skill Center has submitted a budget
9 for Fiscal Year 1990 for review and approval by the
10 Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
12 Council that it does hereby approve the third year
13 request for funding for the Tohono O'Odham Skill Center
14 to provide a Vocational Indian Education Program for
15 Native Americans.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
17 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
18 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
19 being conducted and no executed grant has been awarded
20 by the Office of U.S. Department of Education, Office of
21 Vocational and Adult Education.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
23 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
24 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
25 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
26 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
27 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
28 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
30 on the 14th. day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
31 was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
32 voting; and 07 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
