

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Budget for P.O.N.I. Project)

RES. NO. 257-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been selected as a
2 participant under the Planning Of New Institutions
3 (P.O.N.I. Project) for construction of a Juvenile
4 Detention Center authorized by Public Law 99-570, Title
5 4-subtitle C-cited as the Indian Alcohol and Substance
6 Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act of 1986; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Legislative Council has
8 expressed its interest and intent to contract all phases
9 of the P.O.N.I. Project, directing the Bureau of Indian
10 Affairs to contract with the Tohono O'odham Nation for
11 the initial planning and design phase pursuant to P.L.
12 93-638 and the applicable provisions of 25 CFR, Part 2,
13 by virtue of Resolution No. 08-89; and

14 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has requested a budget to
15 begin the pre-development phase of the contract to
16 determine how the P.O.N.I. requirements will be imple-
17 mented into the planning and design of the juvenile
18 detention and rehabilitation center; and

19 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has prepared, in consultation
20 with the contracting office of the Bureau of Indian
21 Affairs, Facilities Management & Construction Center, a
22 budget reflecting the anticipated costs for the pre-
23 planning developmental phase of the project in the
24 amount of \$97,756.00; and

25 WHEREAS, approval of the budget is critical to the beginning of
26 the planning and design of the proposed juvenile
27 detention and rehabilitation center; and


28 WHEREAS, the proposed budget has been reviewed by both the
29 Judiciary and Budget & Finance Committees of the
30 Legislative Council and recommended for review and
31 approval by the Legislative Council.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2 Council that it does hereby approve the budget submitted
3 in the amount of \$97,756.00 to cover the costs
4 associated with the pre-planning development phase of
5 the Planning of New Institutions program.


6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
7 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
8 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
9 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
10 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
11 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be
12 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
14 on the 14th day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
15 was present with a vote of 1,495.0 for; 229.0 against; -0- not
16 voting; and 07 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
17 Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
18 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
19 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
20 Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant
21 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
