RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Selection of Negotiating Committee for Tribal State Compact - Gaming Activities)

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RES. NO. 259-89 2 WHEREAS, on October 17, 1989, the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act 3 (S.555) was enacted into law providing for (1) a 4 statutory basis for operations of gaming by Indian 5 tribes, (2) a statutory basis for the regulation of 6 gaming by an Indian tribe, and (3) the establishment of 7 independent federal regulatory authority and standards 8 for gaming on Indian lands; and 9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has for many years owned and 10 operated a bingo hall on the San Xavier Reservation 11 herein the game of bingo is played both electronically 12 and manually including other games similar to bingo; and 13 WHEREAS, the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act divides the gaming on 14 Indian lands into three classes, namely, Class I gaming, 15 meaning social games which are unregulated by the Act; 16 Class II gaming such as bingo and games similar to 17 bingo, excluding electronic or electromechanical bingo 18 machines, which are tribally and federally regulated; 19 and Class III gaming, meaning all forms of gaming that 20 are not Class I or Class II gaming; and 21 WHEREAS, the Act further provides that Class III gaming 22 activities are lawful on Indian lands if such activities $\mathbf{23}$ are (1) authorized by a tribal ordinance or resolution, 24 (2) located in a state that permits such gaming 25 activities, and (3) conducted in conformance with a 26 Tribal-State compact entered into by the Indian tribe 27 and the State; and 28 WHEREAS, the Act further provides that for a period of one year 29 from the date of enactment of the Act, Class II gaming 30 includes electronic or electromechanical facsimiles of

1 Indian lands on or before May 1, 1988, if the Indian 2 tribe having jurisdiction over the lands on which such 3 gaming was operated requests the State, by no later than 4 the date that is 30 days after the date of enactment of 5 the Act, to negotiate a Tribal-State compact under the 6 provisions of the Act; and 7 WHEREAS, within 30 days after enactment of the Act, this Council 8 did authorize (Res. No. 314-88) and the Chairman of the 9 Nation did send a request to the State of Arizona to 10 negotiate a Tribal-State compact for the operation of 11 gaming activities within the Tohono O'Odham Nation which 12 are allowable under the provisions of the Indian Gaming 13 Regulatory Act (S.555) only by means of a Tribal-State 14 compact; and 15 WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Arizona has responded to 16 the Nation's request stating that the State is willing 17 to commence negotiations of the Tribal-State compact and 18 requested that the Nation make arrangements with the 19 State to schedule negotiation meetings; and 20 WHEREAS, it's necessary that this Council select a Negotiating 21 Committee to represent the Nation and negotiate the 22 terms and conditions of a Tribal-State compact which 23 terms and conditions shall be subject to Council's 24 approval. 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham 26 Legislative Council does hereby select and appoint the 27 following people to be members of the Nation's 28 Negotiating Committee for the purpose of negotiating a 29 Tribal-State compact with the State of Arizona for the 30 operation of gaming activities within the Tohono O'Odham 31 32

26	Committee will be in effect until negotiations are
27	completed.

29	Council on the 18th. day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 726.0 for; 832.5 against;
30	59.5 not voting; and 106.0 absent, failed to pass because it did not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by
31	Section 2 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
