- WHEREAS, neither topic received preliminary committee review; and WHEREAS, concerns were raised on the procedural aspects of appointing directors and adopting the proposed Reorganization and Consolidation Plan of Governmental Departments; and
- WHEREAS, a recommendation was made to refer both items to the respective Legislative Committees for review and recommendation prior to Council action.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative

 Council that it hereby refers the proposed "Reorganization and Consolidation Plan of Governmental

 Departments" to the Legislative Rules Committee for
 review.
- BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the names submitted for Directors are hereby referred to the appropriate Legislative Committee for review and recommendation.
- BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the respective Legislative Committees return their recommendations to the General Council next month.
- The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18th day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,528.0 for; 196.0 against; -0- not voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
