(Table action on Sif Oidak District Council Res. No. 16/89)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 262-89

1 WHEREAS, on July 18, 1989 the Legislature discussed Sif Oidak
2 District Council Resolution No. 16/89, "Opposing
3 Proposed Legislative Ordinance Defining the Powers,
4 Duties & Authority of the Office of Independent
5 Counsel;" and

6 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council proposed a draft resolu-
7 tion recommending that the Legislature's Judiciary
8 Committee be delegated the authority to oversee the
9 study of the draft ordinance concerning the Independent
10 Counsel; and

11 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council further requested that
12 the Judiciary Committee hold public hearings in order to
13 gain input from the Nation's membership with respect to
14 the proposed Ordinance on the Independent Counsel.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
16 Council hereby tables any action on the recommendations
17 of the Sif Oidak District Council.


18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation's Districts be informed of
19 the Sif Oidak District Council's request.

20 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on
21 the 18th day of July, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was
22 present with a vote of 1,660.5 for; 63.5 against; -0- not voting;
23 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
24 Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
25 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
26 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-
27 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
28 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
