

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Citizen Participation Certification)

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an application
4 for a grant to fund certain eligible Indian Community
5 Development Block Grant Program activities and in
6 connection with such application resolve and made
7 certain assurances.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
9 Council that prior to the submission of its application,
10 the governing body of the Tohono O'odham Nation has
11 provided tribal citizens through their Council Represen-
12 tatives, especially those living in areas where
13 activities are proposed or ongoing, with adequate
14 information concerning the amount of funds available for
15 proposed community development and housing activities,
16 the range of activities that may be assisted, and other
17 important program requirements, and solicited their
18 views and participation.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traditional Tribal means of citizen
20 involvement were followed through District Council
21 meetings and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
22 meetings, and opportunity was given to articulate needs,
23 express preferences about proposed community development
24 and housing activities, assist in the selection of
25 district priorities, and otherwise participate in the
26 development of the application.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any comments or views expressed by
28 Tribal Members were considered and have modified the
29 application accordingly.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the modified application has been
31 made available to Tribal Members for review and comment.

32 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
on the 14th day of August, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,491.0 for; 59.5 against; 173.5 not
voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
by Section 1 (c)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation

1 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
2 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursu-
3 ant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
