3 regarding the closure of its IIM Account; and


4 WHEREAS, such closure will result in the transfer of funds to

7 Council Resolution No. 789-15.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
9 Legislative Council does hereby approve and support the
10 action of the Gu Achi District Council in the closure of
11 its IIM Account with the Bureau of Indian Affairs
12 (BIA), Papago Agency and with the Tribal Accounting
13 Office.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
15 Council does hereby authorize the transfer of funding to
16 First American Credit Union, P. O. Box 99, Casa Grande,
17 Arizona 85222.


18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council

to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






