

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY '89 Budget for Vi-ikam Doag Industries, Inc.)

RES. NO. 27-89

1 WHEREAS, Vi-ikam Doag Industries was chartered as a non-profit
2 public corporation to develop business and employment
3 opportunities in and for the San Lucy District; and

4 WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Vi-ikam Doag Industries has
5 submitted an operating budget for FY 1989 in the sum of
6 \$80,000.00 to support its activities on behalf of the
7 San Lucy District; and

8 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council has reviewed and approves
9 of the activities and expenditures proposed in the
10 submitted budget.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council
12 hereby releases the amount of \$80,000.00 from P.L. 99-
13 503 Funds activities to support and be expended in
14 accordance with Schedule A.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the release of monies will occur only
16 after the Management Agreement (Schedule B) has been
17 executed between Vi-ikam Doag Industries and the
18 General Manager.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that quarterly financial reports for the
20 Sheet Metal Division of the Vi-ikam Doag Industries be
21 submitted to the Tohono O'odham Nation's Accounting
22 Department, the Commerce Committee and the Tohono
23 O'odham Legislative Council.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proposed contract be amended to
25 specify that the General Manager be given 90-days to
26 evaluate Vi-ikam Doag Industries and submit a report to
27 the Legislative Commerce Committee.

29 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
30 on the 26th. day of January, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
31 was present with a vote of 1,169.0 for; 63.0 against; 408.0
32 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursu-
ant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


