	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has adopted a Legislative

4		the week of September 11 - 15, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Members of the Legislative Council are scheduled to attend to important Legislative business matters the week of September 11 - 15, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Nation's FY'90 budget has not been finalized.

WHEREAS, recommendations expressed that it would be in the best interests of the Nation to reschedule the September General Session of the Council from September 11 -15, 1989 to the week of September 18 - 22, 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative

Council that the September General Session scheduled for
the week September 11 - 15, 1989 is hereby rescheduled
to the week of September 18 - 22, 1989, in order to
Members of the Legislature to attend to other matters of
importance to the Nation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that first priority will be given to the Nation's FY '90 Budget and the District FY '90 Budgets.

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,597.0 for; 127.0 against; -0- not voting; 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
