

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(1989 CDBG Grant: Water Project Amendment; Amending Resolution
No. 55-87)

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did authorize application to
3 DHUD - CDBG, by Council Resolution No. 55-87, to fund
4 the Comobabi Water Project; and

5 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 55-87 does direct and authorize the
6 Chairman "...to consult with and negotiate for CDBG
7 funding and to execute any and all contracts and legal
8 documents and any amendments thereto which may be
9 necessary to implement the project; and

10 WHEREAS, CDBG did fund the Comobabi Water Project in the amount
11 of \$292,105.00 of which \$252,827.00 was utilized, for
12 actual construction of the project, including change
13 orders, leaving a balance of \$14,208.00 in unexpended
14 construction funds; and

15 WHEREAS, there remains four homes, in the Comobabi area, not
16 connected to the system, due to anticipated cost, at the
17 time the project was bid; and

18 WHEREAS, it was and is the intent of the Tohono O'odham Nation
19 and Legislature, to provide water service to all
20 residents of the Nation, as funds are available; and

21 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental
22 Health has completed engineering design and cost
23 estimate of providing such service to the four remaining
24 units in the Comobabi area; and

25 WHEREAS, the Office of Environmental Health has contributed
26 \$985.00 in contingency funds, towards this additional
27 work; and

28 WHEREAS, the total estimated additional construction work is
29 estimated to cost \$10,000.00 and the related
30 administrative costs at \$4,208.00; and


31 WHEREAS, there remain adequate, additional funds, within the
32 construction budget, of the original project, to
complete the amended scope of work, including related
administrative activities; and

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has determined
2 that it is in the best interests of the Nation and the
3 best application of CDBG funds, to complete the amended
4 scope of work, including related administrative
5 activities.



8 on the 18th. day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a
9 quorum was present with a vote of 1,610.0 for; -0- against;
10 114.0 not voting; and 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
11 in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the
12 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
13 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
14 Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
15 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
16 Stat. 984).


