WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation agrees that a Housing
Inventory is necessary to justify and efficiently expend
HIP Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has conducted a reassessment of the Housing needs of the reservation; and

WHEREAS, the reassessment has resulted in a corrected increase in the Total Housing on the reservation from 1914 to 2447.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative council that it has reviewed the 1989 Housing Inventory required by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and respectfully submits it for the Bureau funding determination.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,561.0 for; -0- against; 163.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
