

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Modification of Prosecutor's Budget for FY '89)

RES. NO. 317-89

1 WHEREAS, Fiscal Year 1989 ends on September 30, 1989; and  
2 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has a total of \$14,259.34 in its  
3 budget that will not be expended at the end of FY '89;  
4 and  
5 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has shown that \$12,259.34 will  
6 not be expended from its budgetary line item for  
7 Salaries (9010) before September 30, 1989; and  
8 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has shown that \$1,000.00 will  
9 not be expended from its budgetary line item for  
10 Utilities (9150) before September 30, 1989; and  
11 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has shown that \$1,000.00 will  
12 not be expended from its budgetary line item for Program  
13 Supplies before September 30, 1989; and  
14 WHEREAS, the Prosector's Office has shown that it has a need for  
15 an automobile to efficiently conduct its business as  
16 well as a need to provide gas, oil and maintenance for  
17 an automobile; and  
18 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has shown that it has a need for  
19 computer equipment (both hardware and software) for its  
20 program; and  
21 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor's Office has shown that it will be  
22 overexpended on line items for Fringe Benefits and  
23 Travel at the end of FY '89; and  
24 WHEREAS, a modified budget for the Prosecutor's Office was  
25 presented to the Judiciary and Budget and Finance  
26 Committees and is attached hereto; and  
27 WHEREAS, both the Judiciary and Budget & Finance Committees have  
28 reviewed said modified budget and have given their  
29 approval of said modifications; and  
30 WHEREAS, the modified budget shows that \$5,237.00 would be added  
31 to line item for Fringe Benefits (9020), that \$885.84  
32 would be added to line item for Lease/Vehicle (9170),


that \$144.00 would be added to line item for Gas & Oil,

Equipment (9290); and


WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council must approve all

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the modified budget as  
presented by the Prosecutor's Office and attached hereto  
is hereby approved.

on the 20th. day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a  
quorum was present with a vote of 722.5 for; 657.5 against;  
344.0 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested  
in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the  
Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).


