

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Referral of Eye Care to the Health & Human Services Committee and
Setting Date for Special Meeting)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 322-89

1 WHEREAS, on September 20, 1989, the Tohono O'odham Legislative
2 Council addressed the concerns regarding the Arizona
3 Medical Eye Unit and the proposed New Eye Program
4 developed by Indian Health Services to replace contract
5 services currently provided by the Arizona Medical Eye
6 Unit; and

7 WHEREAS, a presentation was provided by the Coordinator for the
8 Arizona Medical Eye Unit which opposed the implementa-
9 tion of the New Eye Program; and

10 WHEREAS, a recommendation was made to provide the Indian Health
11 Service an opportunity to discuss the proposed New Eye
12 Program that is scheduled for implementation on October
13 1, 1989; and

14 WHEREAS, a request was made to schedule additional meetings to
15 address pending budgetary and other matters; and


16 WHEREAS, it was recommended that the issue of eye care be
17 referred to the Health & Human Services Committee.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
19 Council hereby refer the issue of eye care to the
20 Legislative Health & Human Services Committee.

21 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
22 hereby schedules the dates of September 27 and 28, 1989
23 for Special Council Meetings.


24 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on

O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
