

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Adoption of Staffing Base and Base Funding Allocations  
for Tribal Budgets)

RES. NO. 324-89

1 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance committee of the Legislative  
2 Branch and the Executive Review Committee of the Execu-  
3 tive Branch did review and discuss establishing base  
4 funding allocations for those departments, programs,  
5 committees, boards and activities funded with tribal  
6 funds for fiscal year 1990; and

7 WHEREAS, both Committees did also review and discuss establishing  
8 a staffing base for these tribally funded departments,  
9 programs, committees, boards and activities for fiscal  
10 year 1990; and

11 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive  
12 Review Committee does recommend that the Legislative  
13 Council adopt the staffing base and the base allocations  
14 for fiscal year 1990 calculated as follows:

- 15 1. Identify the FY-89 positions and salaries approved  
and effective October 1, 1989.
- 16 2. Addition of a five percent (5%) COLA for all posi-  
17 tions and salaries.
- 18 3. Identify the variance (increase) that this five  
19 percent (5%) COLA created.
- 20 4. Add this five percent (5%) COLA variance to the  
21 budget allocation made for FY-89 and set this new  
22 amount as the base allocation for fiscal year 1990  
except when:
  - a. FY-89 position(s) and salary(ies) are eliminated  
for fiscal year 1990.

23 In this instance, the base allocation for fiscal  
24 year 1990 is reduced by the amount of the FY-89  
25 five percent (5%) COLA variance for that  
26 position(s) and salary(ies) eliminated for  
FY-90; and

27 WHEREAS, both Committees recognize that new positions and/or  
28 reclassified positions have been approved during fiscal  
29 year 1989 which changed the staffing originally approved  
30 beginning October 1, 1989 and does recommend the  
following:


- 31 1. Changes to positions and salaries will be processed  
32 as budget modifications to the approved FY-90 budget  
and processed through the appropriate Committees and  
the Legislative Council.

- 2. Requests for additional funding will be processed as budget modifications to the approved FY-90 budget and processed through the appropriate Committees and Legislative Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby adopts the recommendations of the Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive Review Committee on the staffing base and base allocations for fiscal year 1990 as outlined above.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 22nd. day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,527.0 for; -0- against; 197.0 not voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
