

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting Tohono O'odham Nation's FY '90 Budgets)


RES. NO. 325-89

1 WHEREAS, Fiscal Year 1989 culminates on September 30, 1989; and
2 WHEREAS, authorization of the Nation's Departments and Programs
3 to expend funds ceases at that same time; and
4 WHEREAS, Legislative authorization and appropriation of scopes of
5 Work and Budgets, for the Departments and Programs of
6 the Nation for Fiscal Year 1990 is paramount; and
7 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation to enact such
8 Legislation, prior to inception of FY 1990 (October 1,
9 1989), providing for the continued and uninterrupted
10 delivery of services and activities, to members of the
11 Nation; and
12 WHEREAS, due to the rate of inflation, it is in the best
13 interest of the Nation, to implement a 5% COLA for the
14 employees and officials of the Nation (as established by
15 Resolution No. 49-89 entitled, "Authorization of a 5%
16 COLA for 1990" of the Tohono O'odham Legislature); and
17 WHEREAS, more time is required in order to complete analysis of
18 major elements affecting revenues, activities and
19 budgets of the Nation; and
20 WHEREAS, time is a critical element in promulgating such
21 authorizations and appropriations, requiring timely
22 action by the Nation's Legislature.
23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in the interests of providing
24 budgetary and activity authorization, on a timely basis,
25 the Tohono O'odham Legislature does hereby enact
26 authorization and appropriation of the Scopes of Work
27 and Budgets of the Nation's Departments and Programs for
28 Fiscal Year 1990 in the amount of \$4,304,206.00 .
29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such budgetary authorization shall
30 include a 5% COLA increase, effective October 1, 1989
31 (in accordance with Resolution No. 49-89 entitled,
32 "Authorization of a 5% COLA increase for 1990" of the
Tohono O'odham Legislature.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that due to the restrictions placed on
Departments' and Programs' budgets, in order to emplace
them prior to October 1, 1989, the Tohono O'odham
Legislature will entertain Budget and Scopes of Work
amendments and modifications on or before December 31,
1989.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
on the 22nd day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
was present with a vote of 1,556.0 for; 168.0 against; -0- not
voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on
January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984).




