

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending and Extending the Contract of the
Special Counsel on Counsel)

2 WHEREAS, by contract entered into on March 1, 1989, the Nation
3 contracted with Richard W. Hughes, of the law firm of
4 Rothstein, Bennett, Daly, Donatelli & Hughes, of Santa
5 Fe, New Mexico, as Special Counsel on Counsel, to
6 evaluate the adequacy of the Nation's present
7 arrangements for legal representation and to make
8 recommendations for improving the means by which the
9 Nation obtains the legal advice and representation it
10 requires; and

11 WHEREAS, the Special Counsel on Counsel has performed the tasks
12 set out in the work plan approved in connection with the
13 contract, and has submitted his report of findings and
14 recommendations to the Legislative Council; and

15 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Legislative Council that the
16 Special Counsel on Counsel continue to work with the
17 Legislative Council to develop further and to implement
18 his recommendations, and to provide additional services
19 to the Council in accordance with the attached
20 Supplemental Work Plan; and

21 WHEREAS, the time period and amounts provided for in the contract
22 with Mr. Hughes as Special Counsel on Counsel are
23 inadequate to cover these additional services.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
25 Council as follows:


- 26 1. The Legislative Council hereby approves an
27 amendment to the contract between the Legislative
28 Council of the Nation and Richard W. Hughes and the
29 law firm of Rothstein, Bennett, Daly, Donatelli &
30 Hughes, as Special Counsel on Counsel, extending
31 the expiration date of said contract by nine
32 months, to and until June 30, 1990; enlarging the
maximum amount for fees by \$21,500.00 to a total of
\$37,500.00 and the maximum amount for expenses by
\$2,500.00 to \$4,500.00; and expressly authorizing
the use of lower cost personnel employed by the
Special Counsel's firm in the performance of
services under the contract.

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
- 2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the amendment attached to this Resolution, and upon its execution to forward the same to the Bureau of Indian Affairs for its approval in accordance with federal law.
- 3. The Supplemental Work Plan and Budget attached hereto, showing the services to be provided and the costs thereof, are hereby approved.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 22nd day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,126.0 for; 81.5 against; 516.5 not voting; and 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


