

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Guidelines for the expenditure of funds under Public Law 99-503  
Gila Bend Indian Reservation Lands Replacement Act)

RES. NO. 333-89

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WHEREAS, on October 20, 1986, Public Law 99-503 was enacted into law, authorizing payment to the Tohono O'Odham Nation the sum of Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00) plus interest to be allocated in the following:

- Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00) plus interest in FY 1988
- Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,00) plus interest in FY 1989
- Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,00) plus interest in FY 1990; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 99-503 provides that the authorized Governing Body of the Nation may spend the principal and interest and dividends, accruing on such sums, on behalf of the San Lucy District for land and water rights acquisition, economic and community development, and relocation; and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee recommends that regulation & policy guidelines be developed, adopted, and implemented which would provide guidelines as to how funds under Public Law 99-503 should be expended, in order to meet the requirements of the ACT; and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee does also recommend that the regulation & policy guidelines be developed in coordination with the San Lucy District Council and that a timeline be placed for the development of regulation & policy guidelines to provide guidance and direction to the Nation and the District in the development of future budgets, utilizing funds derived from this ACT.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby adopt the recommendation of the Budget and Finance Committee to promulgate regulation & policy guidelines regarding the use of Public Law 99-503 - Gila Bend Indian Reservation Lands Replacement Act- funds in coordination with the San Lucy District Council.

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2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislature does  
3 direct and authorize the P.L. 99-503 Planning Committee  
4 of the San Lucy District, in cooperation with the Budget  
5 & Finance Committee to develop such regulation & policy  
6 guidelines for review and appropriate action by this  
7 Legislative Body.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Budget and Finance Committee  
9 shall present the regulation & policy guidelines within  
10 six months subsequent to the enactment of this  
11 resolution (Legislative Order), to the Legislative  
12 Council, for review and action.


13 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council

18 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
19 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
20 Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
21 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
22 Stat. 984).

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
