## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Right-of-Way for C.A.P. Water Pipeline)

WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Reclamation has need for a permanent
	easement and right-of-way across two and seventy three
	one hundredths (2.73), plus or minus acres, of Tribal
	land in the "SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 26, T.16 S., R.13E,
	G8 SRM, Pima County, Arizona" in the San Xavier District
	for the purpose of installing a 78" underground
	pipeline, as part of the main C.A.P. water delivery
	system, for the delivery of C.A.P. water to the Nation's
	new farm area, the San Xavier Co-operative Association
	farms and to the Southern Boundary of the San Xavier
	Reservation ending at Pima Mines Roads, a copy of the
	survey map of said easement and right-of-way is attached
	hereto, marked Exhibit A, and made a part hereof; and
WHEREAS,	the Bureau of Reclamation has need for a temporary

whereas, the Bureau of Reclamation has need for a temporary easement and right-of-way across four and forty four one hundredths (4.44) plus acres in the "SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 26, T.16 S., R.13E., G8 SRM, Pima County, Arizona" in the San Xavier District for temporary use during the period of construction of the C.A.P. water delivery system, a copy of the survey map of said temporary easement and right-of-way is attached hereto

marked as Exhibit B and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, an appraisal of the value of the tribal land to be utilized for these permanent and temporary easements and rights-of-way has been done and the conclusion of the appraiser was that the two and seventy three one hundredths (2.73), plus or minus acres across tribal land, together with the 4.44 temporary easement and right-of-way across tribal land would have a value of \$85,500.00 for the said easements and rights-of-way as above described; and

rights-of-way as above described; and WHEREAS, the Nation's Legislative Natural Resource Committee has reviewed the appraisal and the purpose and basis for determining the value of the land to be utilized for the requested easements and rights-of-way and after several meetings with parties involved, has decided to accept the offer of the Bureau of Reclamation in the amount of \$136,800.00 for the said permanent and temporary

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation has agreed to pay to the

Nation an additional 60% of the appraised value, or

fifty one thousand three hundred (\$51,300.00), for a

total amount of \$136,800.00 for said easements and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Nation if the Nation accepts payment of the sum of \$136,800.00 for the land described on Exhibits A and B, attached hereto, to be utilized for the permanent and temporary easements and rights-of-way described therein; and

easements and rights-of-way as aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, there are currently no provisions in the Tohono O'Odham government system that specifically address easements and rights-of-way distributions; and

WHEREAS, the legal opinion provided by the Tohono O'Odham Nation's legal counsel indicated that the Nation's current lease ordinance has no bearing on easements and rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Natural Resources Committee has previously consented to approving and supporting San Xavier District's request for similar fees stemming from the El Paso Natural Gas Twin Buttes rights-of-way, and the Central Arizona Project, Black Mountain right-of-way.

NOW .

 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
Legislative Council does hereby (accept) the Bureau of
Reclamation's proposal to pay the sum of \$136,800.00
for the easements and rights-of-way described on
Exhibits A and B, attached hereto, consisting of two and
seventy three one hundredths (2.73), plus or minus acres
of Tribal lands within the San Xavier Reservation, to be
utilized for the purpose of the installation of a 78"
pipeline for the delivery of C.A.P. water to the
Nation's new farm area, the San Xavier Co-operative
Association farms and to the Southern Boundary of the
San Xavier Reservation; and four and forty four one
hundredths (4.44) plus acres, for temporary use during
the period of construction on said pipeline.

approves the disbursement of 100% of all proceeds derived from the granting of said easement and rights-of-way described on Exhibit A and B, attached hereto, on San Xavier District tribal/district lands for the installation of a permanent easement and right-of-way together with the temporary easement and right-of-way for temporary use during the course of construction and installation of the C.A.P. pipeline.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby directed to disburse the above-referenced amount to the San Xavier District upon receipt of payment from Reclamation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Nation, or his designee is authorized to execute all necessary agreements or other documents to effectuate this permanent easement and right-of-way described on Exhibit A, and temporary easement and right-of-way, described on Exhibit B.
