

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Health Department Staff Training In AIDS Counseling)

RES. NO. 344-89

1 WHEREAS, on the Tohono O'Odham Nation, the cases of AIDS and the
2 cases of AIDS virus carriers are low; and

3 WHEREAS, it is anticipated that there will be an increase in
4 cases of AIDS because of AIDS virus carriers; and

5 WHEREAS, in order to meet the needs of our O'Odham with AIDS,
6 staff in the Health Department need to be trained in
7 counseling with People with Aids (PWA); and

8 WHEREAS, Indian Health Services allocated \$11,782.00 for AIDS
9 activities in April, 1989; and

10 WHEREAS, the \$11,782.00 needs to be obligated and extended in
11 Fiscal Year 1990; and

12 WHEREAS, a proposal for Health Department Staff counseling
13 training and to assist them in counseling with People
14 with Aids (PWA); and

15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council is in support of
16 the proposal for Health Department Staff counseling
17 training to meet the needs of people with AIDS on Tohono
18 O'Odham Nation's Reservation.


19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham
20 Legislative Council approves the program of the Tohono
21 O'Odham Health Department Staff training in counseling
22 at a cost of \$11,782.00 and approves the extension of
23 the \$11,782.00 into Fiscal Year 1990.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
25 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
26 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
27 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
28 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
29 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be
30 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.



The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 28th day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,667.0 for; 57.0 against; -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




