

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Requesting NCAI Support for Border Tribes Summit)

RES. NO. 346-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation by resolutions through its
2 Legislative Council have recognized the Hia-Ced O'Odham
3 and the O'Odham of Mexico as members of the Tohono
4 O'Odham Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Hia-Ced O'Odham and the O'Odham of Mexico have
6 struggled to retain and regain their aboriginal
7 homelands that have been deceitfully occupied by non-
8 O'Odham; and

9 WHEREAS, the civil, constitutional and human rights of the Hia-
10 Ced O'Odham and O'Odham of Mexico have been violated;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the Hia-Ced O'Odham and the O'Odham of Mexico have
13 organized to combat the in justice being committed
14 against them; and

15 WHEREAS, the Hia-Ced O'Odham and the O'Odham of Mexico are in the
16 process of hosting a summit meeting of other "border
17 tribes" for the purpose of exchanging information on the
18 national level; and

19 WHEREAS, the "Border Tribes Summit" would provide possible
20 solutions border tribes on a national level; and


21 WHEREAS, the Hia-Ced O'Odham and O'Odham of Mexico and the Tohono
22 O'Odham Nation call upon all Indian Nations for unity.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation
24 urges the National Congress of American Indians at its
25 46th. Annual Convention to endorse and support the
26 "Border Tribes Summit" to be held in the San Xavier
27 District of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, near Tucson,
28 Arizona, during the week of October 15-21, 1989.


29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the National Congress of American
30 Indians do everything within its power to assist Border
31 Tribes Summit.

1 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
2 on the 28th. day of September, 1989 at a meeting at which a
3 quorum was present with a vote of 1,607.5 for; 116.5 against;
4 -0- not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested
5 in the Council by Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the
6 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
7 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
8 Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
9 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
10 Stat. 984).



27 submittal.


