RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Requesting NCAI Support For The Respect of Human Remains)

RES. NO.347-89

WHEREAS,	the World Archaeological Congress on the Disposition of
	the Dead which was held in Vermillion, South Dakota in
	August 1989 passed a policy statement which addressed
	the ethics of archaeologists with respect to human
	remains; and

WHEREAS, the policy statement demands respect for mortal remains of the deceased and respect for the disposition of such remains based on the wishes of the local community or relatives or quardians of the deceased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby requests the 46th National Congress of American Indians to support the Archaeological Congress Policy Statement on Human Remains and their disposition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby requests the National Congress of American Indians to advocate passage of enforceable laws which protect American Indian cemeteries, grave sites, and burial mounds, and which advocate the return of curated remains and burial possessions to appropriate tribes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that if fully reinforces and supports this resolution and presents it on behalf of the San Xavier District, the Tohono O'Odham Nation, and American Indians and Alaska Natives, to the 46th Annual National Congress of American Indians Conference in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in October 1989.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>28th.</u> day of <u>September</u>, <u>1989</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,614.0</u> for; <u>57.0</u> against; 53.0 not voting; and -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section (j) of Article VI of the Constitution the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
