WHEREAS, Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act (SAWRSA) of 1982 (P. L. 97-293) was enacted to settle the water claims of the San Xavier and Schuk Toak Districts of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has encountered numerous problems, questions, and issues as a result of implementing this legislation; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has concluded that Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act has eroded tribal self-determination by governing that development of water for agriculture purposes be funded by the United States Government while development of water for all other purposes be funded solely by the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and

WHEREAS, at the August 22, 1989 forum on Tribal Settlements, held at Sundance, Utah, it was proposed that a Western Tribes Water Policy Council be formed to establish a network among the western tribes as it pertains to water rights; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council strongly urges that tribes litigate violated water rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it hereby requests the National Congress of American Indians to reaffirm water rights for all tribes at their 46th annual conference and that the National Congress of American Indians urge and support tribes to pursue water rights litigation, and encourage and support the formation of a Western Tribes Water Policy Council.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative IT Council hereby reinforces and supports this resolution
