

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Override of Vetoed Resolution No. 320-89, "Special Funding
Request for Border Tribes Summit" with Amendment)

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did by Resolution
3 No. 320-89, approve a special funding request for the
4 Border Tribes Summit; and

5 WHEREAS, upon presentation of Resolution No. 320-89, "Special
6 Funding Request for Border Tribes Summit" to the Chair-
7 man of the Tohono O'Odham Nation he did disapprove
8 thereof and returned it to the Council with his
9 objections in accordance with the provisions of Article
10 VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
11 Nation; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed the
13 Chairman's objections and after consideration again
14 voted to pass Resolution No. 320-89, "Special Funding
15 Request for Border Tribes Summit" with the stipulation
16 that the Hia Ced and O'odham In Mexico Programs work
17 closely and in coordination with the Nation's Executive
18 Office with respect to the "Border Tribes Summit."

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legis-
20 lative Council does hereby override the Chairman's veto
21 of Resolution No. 320-89, "Special Funding for Border
22 Tribes Summit," by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the
23 votes cast 1,149.0.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 320-89, "Special
25 Funding Request for Border Tribes Summit" is hereby
26 amended to stipulate that the Hia Ced O'odham and the
27 O'odham in Mexico Programs are hereby directed to work
28 closely and in coordination with the Nation's Executive
29 Office with respect to the Border Tribes Summit.

30 The foregoing resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham
31 Legislative Council on the 10th. day of October, 1989, at a
32 meeting at which a quorum was present and, by a vote of 1,724.0
for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 06 absent, was passed by a
majority of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast and
became law as provided in Section 5 of Article VII of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.


