- WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did by Resolution
 No. 320-89, approve a special funding request for the
 Border Tribes Summit; and
- WHEREAS, upon presentation of Resolution No. 320-89, "Special Funding Request for Border Tribes Summit" to the Chairman of the Tohono O'Odham Nation he did disapprove thereof and returned it to the Council with his objections in accordance with the provisions of Article VII, Section 5 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and
- WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed the Chairman's objections and after consideration again voted to pass Resolution No. 320-89, "Special Funding Request for Border Tribes Summit" with the stipulation that the Hia Ced and O'odham In Mexico Programs work closely and in coordination with the Nation's Executive Office with respect to the "Border Tribes Summit."
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council does hereby override the Chairman's veto of Resolution No. 320-89, "Special Funding for Border Tribes Summit," by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast 1,149.0.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 320-89, "Special Funding Request for Border Tribes Summit" is hereby amended to stipulate that the Hia Ced O'odham and the O'odham in Mexico Programs are hereby directed to work closely and in coordination with the Nation's Executive Office with respect to the Border Tribes Summit.

The foregoing resolution was presented to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10th. day of October , 1989, at a meeting at which a quorum was present and, by a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 06 absent, was passed by a majority of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast and became law as provided in Section 5 of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
