

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Tabling Action on the Juvenile Crime Reduction Grant  
Indirect Cost Issue to be addressed)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 358-89

1 WHEREAS, on October 24, 1989, the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
2 Council had the following three items on their agenda:

3 Item #3 Juvenile Crime Reduction Grant  
4 Item #6 Robert Wood Johnson Foundation Diabetes  
5 Prevention Project  
6 Item #7 National Rural Health Association COPC  
7 Demonstration Project; and

8 WHEREAS, the listed proposals were submitted by the Program and/or  
9 Branch to the respective funding agencies; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has an established percentage  
11 rate for indirect cost; and

12 WHEREAS, for the three proposed funding requests, the respective  
13 funding agencies either disallows indirect cost on their  
14 grant awards or allows it at a reduced rate; and

15 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Budget & Finance Committee to  
16 recoup indirect costs on all grants/contracts obtained by  
17 the Nation, except when a waiver is approved by the Tohono  
18 O'odham Legislative Council; and

19 WHEREAS, the three proposals have been awarded funds but require  
20 Council authorization to expend them; and

21 WHEREAS, during the discussion for item number three, "Juvenile  
22 Crime Reduction Grant," the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
23 Council recommended that all funding proposals for grants  
24 or contracts be processed through the Nation's Grants and  
25 Contracts Office; and

26 WHEREAS, other questions were raised regarding indirect cost and  
27 that the Nation should be consistent in addressing the  
28 issue.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
30 Council that it hereby tables action on the Juvenile Crime  
31 Reduction Grant, the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation  
32 Diabetes Prevention Project, and the National Rural Health  
Association COPC Demonstration Project until the issue of  
indirect cost is resolved.

1 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
2 requests that the Juvenile Crime Reduction Grant be  
3 administered by the Nation's Grants and Contracts Program.


4 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the  
5 24th day of October, 1990 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
6 present with a vote of 887.0 for; 182.5 against; 488.5 not voting;  
7 166.0 (09) absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
8 Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
9 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18,  
10 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
11 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
12 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
