

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tabling the Appointment of Representatives to the
Tribal Private Industry Council)

RES. NO. 368-89

1
2 WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act, Public Law 97-300
3 authorizes the expenditures of federal funds for job
4 training programs in Service Delivery Areas designated
5 by the Governor of the State in accordance with a Job
6 Training Plan for each area; and

7 WHEREAS, nineteen (19) Indian Reservations, including the Tohono
8 O'Odham Nation, have been designated as a Tribal Service
9 Delivery Area for purposes of administering JTPA funds;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the Chief Elected Officials of each of the nineteen (19)
12 Tribes according to Section 102 (d) (2) of the Act shall
13 appoint members to the Tribal Private Industry Council;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, on July 26, 1989 the Executive Office of the Tohono
16 O'Odham Nation received a notice requesting
17 appointment/reappointments to the Tribal Private
18 Industry Council; and

19 WHEREAS, the Executive Office of the Tohono O'Odham Nation has on
20 October 25, 1989 recommended for appointment to the
21 Tribal Private Industry Council the names of Willard
22 Anita and Joseph Joaquin, respectively; and

23 WHEREAS, the names of Willard Anita and Joseph Joaquin were, upon
24 review and approval, submitted by the Human Resources
25 Development Committee to the Legislative Council for
26 consideration; and

27 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council questions the
28 eligibility of the nominees due to the constitutional
29 requirement of restricting elected officials for holding
30 more than one office; and

31 WHEREAS, the Council further questions the selection process in
32 determining the Chairman's nominations, and desires that
the selection be from members at large; and

1 WHEREAS, certain members of the Legislative Council are not aware
2 of the authorities and functions of the Private Industry
3 Council and requests a full report on the (PIC) before
4 appointment are to be reviewed and approved.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
6 Council that the nominations for the Tribal Private
7 Industry Council are hereby tabled until the Tohono
8 O'odham Legislative Council have been provided with a
9 full report as to the authorities and functions of the
10 Tribal Private Industry Council and the manner of
11 selecting nominees have been clarified.


12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
13 on the 13th. day of November, 1989 at a meeting at which a
14 quorum was present with a vote of 1,599.0 for; -0- against;
15 125.0 not voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested
16 in the Council by Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the
17 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
18 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting
19 Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March
20 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
21 Stat. 984).



submittal.

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
