WHEREAS,	the Gila River Indian Community, in an attempt to
	recover, repatriate and rebury some 450 Hohokam human
	remains and associated grave goods excavated from within
	the Papago Freeway right-of-way within the Phoenix
	metropolitan area, was advised by the Arizona State
	Museum that such archaeological remains could not be
	released by the museum to the community because other
	Indian communities, tribes or nations with common
	ancestors or histories might make conflicting claims
	for the same remains; and

whereas, the Gila River Indian Community has sought the advice and cooperation of the other three central-Arizona Indian communities, namely the Ak-Chin Indian Community, the Salt River Maricopa Indian Community and the Tohono O'Odham Nation, in its attempt to repatriate the Hohokam archaeological remains excavated from within the Papago Freeway right-of-way and to rebury the human remains; and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee of the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed the request of the Gila River Indian Community and has recommended that the Legislative Council support the recovery and repatriation by the Gila River Indian Community of the Hohokam human remains and associated grave goods excavated from within the Papago Freeway right-of-way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
Council that it does hereby support the request by the
Gila River Indian Community to recover, repatriate and
rebury the Hohokam human remains and associated grave
goods excavated from within the Papago Freeway right-ofway, and on behalf of the Tohono O'Odham Nation does
hereby release the Arizona State Museum and any other

person or agency having custody thereof from all claims, liability and responsibility for releasing and delivering such remains and associated grave goods to the Gila River Indian Community for repatriation and burial.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th. day of February , 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,354.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 286.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c) and (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
