

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Community Oriented Primary Care)

RES. NO. 374-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation did submit a proposal to the
2 National Rural Health Association, Hospital Research
3 and Education Trust to provide technical assistance and
4 to support the Tohono O'odham Health Department in
5 implementation of the Community Oriented Primary Care
6 methodology services delivery; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by Resolution No.
8 237-88 did review the submittal of the proposal; and

9 WHEREAS, the Nation has been awarded the project effective March
10 01, 1989 - August 31, 1991 in the amount of \$72,500.00;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Health Department has submitted a
13 budget for review and approval for implementation of
14 program objectives; and

15 WHEREAS, indirect cost are retained by the National Rural health
16 Association for administrative services; and


17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does request the Tohono
18 O'odham Health Department to proceed in coordination
19 with the Tribal Accounting Office in requesting that any
20 indirect dollars be returned to the Nation to provide
21 services.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
23 Council that it does hereby approve and authorize
24 expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.


25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
26 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: The
27 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
28 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,
29 provided, however, that any amendments affecting the
30 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be
31 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 20th day of November, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,550.5 for; -0- against; 173.5 not voting; 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




