


RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(O'odham in Mexico FY '90 Budget Modification #1)


1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the  
O'odham in Mexico Program with tribal funds; and  
2 WHEREAS, amendments affecting the funding level or change in the  
3 purpose for which the funds were budgeted are required  
4 to be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono  
5 O'odham Legislative Council; and  
6 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and approval.  
7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
8 Council that it hereby approves this amendment and  
9 authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached  
10 budget.

11 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
12 on the 20th day of November, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum  
13 was present with a vote of 1,664.5 for; -0- against; 59.5 not  
14 voting; 06 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
15 by Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the  
16 Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on  
17 January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
18 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursu-  
19 ant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).






