

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of Title II Grant "Family Preservation Project")

RES. NO. 37-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department has the
2 primary responsibility to provide for the care,
3 treatment and welfare of children found to be in need of
4 such care; and

5 WHEREAS, Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978
6 provides funds for development of child welfare programs
7 under specified terms and conditions; and

8 WHEREAS, the incidence of child abuse and neglect in the Tohono
9 O'Odham Nation is high and increasing and family
10 intervention and prevention services are limited; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Department is capable
12 of developing and administering a home based, intensive
13 family service program which will focus on preventing
14 family breakups and reunification of families; and

15 WHEREAS, the need for a program which preserves the family
16 through service provision is well documented.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
18 Council that it does hereby approve the application of
19 Tohono O'Odham Social Service for a Three Year Title II
20 grant to develop and implement a Family Preservation
21 Project which will decrease the incidents of child abuse
22 and neglect and decrease the number of children in out
23 of home placements through an intensive family service
24 program with educational, advocacy, counseling, and
25 social service components.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or
27 Treasurer of the Tohono O'Odham Nation are hereby
28 authorized to negotiate and execute this grant and any
29 amendments thereto for the duration of the grant,
30 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
31 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be
32 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th. day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,233.5 for; 120.5 against; -0- not voting; and 286.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
