- WHEREAS, the need for a program which preserves the family through service provision is well documented.

 Council that it does hereby approve the application of

 Tohono O'Odham Social Service for a Three Year Title II

 grant to develop and implement a Family Preservation

 Project which will decrease the incidents of child abuse

 and neglect and decrease the number of children in out

 of home placements through an intensive family service

 program with educational, advocacy, counseling, and

 social service components.
