(Contract for O'Odham In Mexico Legal Representation)

2 WHEREAS, the O'Odham In Mexico Office and Board has started its  
3 legal and political struggle to reclaim the O'Odham  
4 Lands of Mexico, and has become critical to have legal  
5 counsel; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. George Barnett and Associates has been successful in  
7 helping the O'Odham In Mexico Office and O'Odham In  
8 Mexico in getting the Mexican Government to respond on  
9 the land problems; and

10 WHEREAS, the O'Odham In Mexico Office and Board has proposed to  
11 hire Mr. Barnett for FY '90 to continue the legal  
12 consulting until such time as the Bureau of Indian  
13 Affairs approves his contract; and

14 WHEREAS, it is a crucial time for the O'Odham In Mexico in  
15 dealing with the Mexican Officials in reclaiming its  
16 aboriginal lands, respect for its Human Rights,  
17 Traditions and Cultural Rights.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's  
19 Legislative Council hereby approves this contract for  
20 the O'Odham In Mexico in the amount of \$139,600.00 .

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Domestic Affairs Committee is  
22 delegated the oversight and monitoring responsibilities  
23 for the O'Odham In Mexico Program, Scope of Work, and  
24 Budget.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
26 that Mr. George Salazar Barnett of the Law Offices of  
27 DOLNY, O'HARE & BARNETT, P.C. be employed by the Tohono  
28 O'Odham Nation under and pursuant to the terms of the  
29 attached Special Council Agreement, and any amendments  
30 or extensions thereof, and the Chairman of the Tohono  
31 O'Odham Nation is hereby authorized to execute said  
32 agreement for and on behalf of the Tohono O'Odham  
Nation.


1 The foregoing Resolution was presented to the Tohono O'odham  
2 Council on the 4th. day of December, 1989 at a meeting at which  
3 a quorum was present with a vote of 141.0 for; 1,401.0 against;  
4 182.0 not voting; and 03 absent, failed to pass because it did  
5 not receive a majority of the votes cast as required by Section 2  
6 of Article V of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation.
