

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Special Meeting - December 14, 1989 - O'odham in Mexico Issues)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 386-89

1 WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Order No. 381-89, "Amending  
2 Council's Running Agenda - December 1989 General Session"  
3 the following O'odham in Mexico items were included,  
4 specifically: 1) O'odham in Mexico Contract with George  
5 Barnett; 2) O'odham in Mexico FY '90 Budget Modification;  
6 and

7 WHEREAS, concerns were expressed that the proposed contract and  
8 the Budget Modification had not received appropriate  
9 Committee reviews; and

10 WHEREAS, major funding appropriations were requested for the  
11 attorney contract and budget for the O'odham in Mexico  
12 Program; and

13 WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee contended that the contract  
14 and budget were to be considered critical in nature and  
15 required timely Council consideration.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
17 Council that it hereby refers issues of the O'odham in  
18 Mexico budget and attorney contract to all appropriate  
19 Committees for a joint review on December 11, 1990.

20 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that any Committee concerned with the O'odham  
21 in Mexico issues attend the joint review.

22 BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
23 hereby establishes December 14, 1989 as a day for a  
24 Special Meeting to address the O'odham in Mexico attorney  
25 Contract and the O'odham in Mexico Budget.


26 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham

28 quorum was present with a vote of 1,046.0 for; 112.5 against; 565.5  
29 not voting; 03 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
30 by Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
31 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January  
32 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
