

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Amending Council's Agenda - December 28, 1989)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 398-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council met in a Special
2 Session on December 28, 1989 to address contracts and
3 budgets; and

4 WHEREAS, the established agenda for the day was presented to and
5 reviewed by the Legislative Council; and

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative

26 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
27 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursu-
29 ant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
