

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Referring "Archaeological Mitigation Recommendations for Schuk  
Toak Farm Development" to the Cultural Preservation Committee)

LEGIS. ORDER NO. 48-89

1 WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee has introduced a  
2 draft resolution that recommends guidelines for the  
3 Archaeological Mitigation at the Schuk Toak Farm  
4 Development; and

5 WHEREAS, certain understandings of the Schuk Toak District were  
6 not included in the proposed guidelines; and

7 WHEREAS, clarifications were recommended before the formal  
8 adoption of the proposed mitigation guidelines.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
10 Council that it hereby refers the draft resolution  
11 titled, "Archaeological Mitigation Recommendations for  
12 Schuk Toak Farm Development" to the Cultural Preserva-  
13 tion Committee.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Cultural Preservation Committee  
15 work with the Schuk Toak District Representatives to  
16 include any changes to the recommended guidelines for  
17 the Schuk Toak Farm Development Archeological Mitigation  
18 Plan.

19 The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on  
20 the 9th day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum  
21 was present with a vote of 1,460.0 for; -0- against; 180.0 not  
22 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
23 Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
24 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.  
984).
