

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorization of a 5% COLA for 1990)

RES. NO. 49-89

1 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the
2 Consumer Price Index change for the prior calendar year
3 and the rate of inflation continues in excess of four
4 (4) percent; and


5 WHEREAS, the Committee recommends to the Council that the wage
6 and salary levels of all employees of the Nation be
7 increased by five (5) percent for the fiscal year
8 beginning October 1, 1989; and

9 WHEREAS, the cycle for renewal of grant and contract applications
10 for FY 1990 has started for programs on funding year
11 cycles different from the Nation's fiscal year, and
12 approval of the wage and salary increase at this time
13 will simplify the budgeting process for all contracts
14 and grants for Fiscal Year 1990.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of
16 the Tohono O'Odham Nation approves wage and salary
17 increases in the amount of five (5) percent for all
18 Nation's employees for fiscal year 1990. This increase
19 shall take effect on October 01, 1989.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
21 on the 9th. day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum
22 was present with a vote of 1,424.0 for; -0- against; 216.0 not
23 voting; and 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the
24 Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of
25 the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation
26 on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
27 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986,
28 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
29 984).
