

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Supporting 4,000 Housing Units for Indian Country)

RES. NO. 55-89

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation of Arizona still has unmet  
2 needs in housing for its tribal members; and

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation supports the continued funding  
4 from the Department of H.U.D. as one way of addressing  
5 the housing issue; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation opposes the recommendation of  
7 Office of Management and Budget (O.M.B.) to zeroing out  
8 funding for Indian Housing in the 1990 Budget; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is on record supporting the  
10 call for 4,000 units per year in Indian housing to meet  
11 the need.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Nation  
13 supports the continued funding of the Indian Housing  
14 Program at a level that would adequately meet the needs  
15 of Indian Country.


16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
17 on the 10th. day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a  
18 quorum was present with a vote of 1,399.0 for; -0- against; -0-  
19 not voting; and 241.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in  
20 the Council by Section 1 (c), (2), & (f) of Article VI of the  
21 Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
22 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting  
23 Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March  
24 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
25 Stat. 984).
