

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Requesting increase in Federal Appropriations
for Road Maintenance)

RES. NO. 57-89

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WHEREAS, federal appropriations for road maintenance for the Tohono O'Odham Nation are currently set at \$262,000.00 and result in the attached operating budget for the Branch of Roads of the Papago Agency which establishes that there are approximately 325 miles of paved roads and 518 miles of earth roads within the Nation served by a maintenance crew of six persons and twelve pieces of equipment; and

WHEREAS, because of funding constraints, the Branch of Roads is currently able to maintain only 287 miles of 518 miles of earth roads, and is unable to effectively maintain the increasing number of paved roads which are deteriorating almost as rapidly as new paving is added to existing earth roads; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee of the Legislative Council has determined that a crisis will result if existing roads are permitted to deteriorate at current rates, and has recommended that the Nation seek additional appropriations for road maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Council concurs in the Committee's determination and recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does hereby urgently request that Congress increase its appropriations for road maintenance for the Tohono O'Odham Nation and that the appropriate officers of the Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate members and committees of Congress.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 10th. day of February, 1989 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,399.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; and 241.0 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c), (2), & (f) of Article VI of the


